The Pluriverse: Challenges of Post- Developmentalist Thought for Global South Studies

The multiple crises of coercive globalization have called into question concepts such as development, progress and modernization. In the face of this questioning, pluriversal thinking offers a radical "alternative for thinking alternatives" (Santos:) to Western hegemony. For this reason, the 2022 version of the CIVIS School "North South Encounters" invites a debate on the pluriverse as a methodological theoretical framework, originating in the post-developmental thought and epistemologies of the Global South that have been widely disseminated both in academia, social and political activism and cultural production. The possibility of designs for potentially other worlds challenges the supposed homogenization produced by economic globalization and the geopolitics of knowledge that conceptualizes the world exclusively from the Global North. The pluriverse invites the articulation of world designs that originate from practices, from new political ontologies, from peripheral communities, and imply a resolute search for cognitive justice, good living, and a world into which many worlds fit. In accordance with the trans- real and transdisciplinary project of Global South studies, this conference will combine theoretical debates with scholars from the CIVIS network (from Europe and Africa), alongside colleagues from Asia-Pacific and Latin America, with a dialogue between academia, art and political activism.
